

His aunt bought him volumes of short stories, and his uncle, a dairyman, bought him a mouth organ and engaged him in solving crossword puzzles.






This student was always partying and laughing

This lawyer from an aristocratic British family, was in fact Indian and fights for his country's independence using pacifism, is...




Mohandas Gandhi






He failed to reach the required standard in several subjects, but obtained exceptional grades in physics and mathematics. He strongly objected to rote learning.


This young pioneer was hated and considered a cockroach by his classmates, is...







